Day 1 Arrival in Praia Transfer to the Hotel



Day 2: Santiago City Tour + Sucupira + Old Town with lunch in a typical restaurant The tour starts at Alexandre Albuquerque Square, visits the Church of Nossa Senhora da Graça, the Amílcar Cabral and Ethnological Museum, the Municipal Market, Largo Diogo Gomes, visit the Center Beach Museum.

Visit the Sucupira market and continue towards Cidade Velha, the first capital of Cape Verde and the first city built by Europeans in Africa. Here you can visit the historical monuments that date back to colonial times, namely the São Filipe Fort ordered to be built by King Philip II of Spain I of Portugal in 1578; go down to the city center, passing by the Ruins of the Cathedral (1556), visiting the Pelourinho (monument symbol of royal justice and its execution) built in 1512, the Church of Nossa Senhora do Rosário, and the Convent of São Francisco (1640). The visit ends at "Praia da Frente" where traditional lunch will be served and it will be possible to buy some memories before returning to Praia.

Day 3: Santiago

Excursion back to the island Journey to discover Mother Island, to discover its contrasts from the mountains, green valleys, and white or black sand beaches. Departure from the hotel in Cidade da Praia, passing through Avenida Cidade de Lisboa, Government Palace, football stadium, library, Municipal auditorium, a statue of Amílcar Cabral – national hero, and Sucupira. It continues towards the interior of the Island, the first stop being in São Domingos for a visit to the Ecocentro. Continue on to pass through the Municipalities of João Teves dos Órgãos, São Salvador do Mundo and arrive in Assomada, Municipality of Santa Catarina for the City Tour. Then, head towards the North of the Island, stopping at Serra Malagueta, one of the highest points on the island at around 1,064 meters high, overlooking Ribeira Principal below.



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Upon arriving in Tarrafal, visit the former political prison ordered built by the Portuguese fascist regime in 1936. City tour and lunch that may be preceded by a swim (optional) on the beaches of Tarrafal. The return is along the coast of the island, with some stops at the most important points, such as the "Rabelados" community, banana plantation in Santa Cruz, Pedra Badejo, and the recent Poilão dam.

Day 4: São Vicente – City Tour – Half Day Transfer out from the hotel to the airport, flight to São Vicente to buy City tour – visit to Praça Nova, Ex Casa do Senador Vera Cruz, Edifício CV Telecom (Ex Telegraph), Rua 5 de July, Eagle Monument, Mindelo Cultural Center (craft shop). The tour continues along Avenida Marginal, Marina, Replica of the Belém Tower, Fish Market, Vegetable and Fruit Market, Praça Estrela, and Rua do Coco (Atelier Bela Duarte). Passing by the Nossa Senhora da Luz Church you reach Casa Cesária Évora ending at Rua de Lisboa and Rua Baltazar Lopes da Silva. Return to the Hotel Rest of the day Free.

Day 5: São Vicente - return to the island - Full day with lunch Departure from the Hotel towards the fishing village of São Pedro (if customers are lucky they can see the arrival of the fish), continue until Monte Verde where there is a 360 degree view of the island. Continue to the fishing village of Salamansa. Lunch is served in a typical restaurant in Baía das Gatas, and if you wish, you can relax and go diving. After lunch, arrive at Praia Grande and Calhau and end in Madeiral

Day 6: Free day, with the possibility of visiting the island of Santo Antão (See price).

Day 7: Return to Praia City
